

# Making Gold in World of Warcraft

World of Warcraft is an extremely successful and popular game. In fact, Blizzard Entertainment has made it the standard in massive multi-player role-playing games. The game has a simulated economy that runs on gold won in battle or via the sales of goods and services. To make improvements to a player's character, gold is necessary and therefore highly desirable. There is more than one way to get [WoW Gold](#), and this article will suggest ways a player can earn enough to make the purchases that will put their characters at the top of the battle.

Of all the great ways to earn in-game gold, there are two that always produce results: farming and the auction house. Both boast ease of use, and are readily available to all classes and levels in the game. However, they do require some time and patience if you want to make it truly worth your while. Putting it bluntly, farming is just killing monsters, enemies, etc... over and over to reap their ever replenished **WoW gold** and [WoW items](#) (which can in turn be sold for more gold.) As is the case in any game there are some areas that seem custom built for the avid farmer. Some traits to look for are easy kills, fair amount of [Cheap WoW Gold](#), and quick respawn. You can always farm all at once, however if you'd like to keep your sanity, along with a fair amount of money, available at all times it's best to farm consistently throughout your playing time and build up a supply steadily. When you get high enough you could even try out Winterspring which boasts some of the more favored "farmlands" particularly in and around the Lake of Ke'theril with drops that are worth hundreds of gold pieces.

If farming doesn't seem like it fits your style you could always hop over to the auction house. Nine times out of ten the auction house will provide you with more gold for your drops than any npc

merchant could ever give you. Another bonus is as you develop your secondary skills, i.e. mining, skinning, leatherworking, the auction house is the perfect place to unload all your little hand crafted goodies. Make sure to note which items sell faster, sell most, and bring in the most gold, so that you can mark pet locations, store locations, and monster locations for quicker cash. Another good thing to remember on your journeys is to watch what some merchant items sell for. Although you may know which store sells plans on how to craft a certain pair of boots not all players do, or can reach the place they are bought at. So sometimes even what seems to you to be the easiest [WoW item](#) to get can bring a great return at the auction house.

This article isn't comprehensive—there are so many ways to earn gold that you might fill a library with ways to do it, but the strategies here will help you get started. Nonetheless, these two tips will help you to consistently succeed.
